## **Rebels Soccer Club Financial Aid Program**

1. Requests for financial aid must come from the player's parents or legal guardian. Players requesting financial aid must be playing U8 to U17 level soccer.
2. Eligibility is based upon the following criteria:
  - A player's acceptance into his/her school's free or reduced lunch program. The model used is the policy and procedures of Anoka-Hennepin Independent School District #11. No financial information is required providing the player's parents/guardians provide a copy of the letter confirming acceptance into the free or reduced lunch program of the player's school.
  - All other financial hardship requests must be submitted in writing to the Financial Aid Committee.
3. A player's family may receive financial aid once per calendar year. The player is responsible for the non-refundable tryout fee deposit. Any financial aid given is to be applied to the remainder of the season registration fees. The player is responsible for all team fees including tournament and additional training fees.
4. Acceptance into the RSC financial aid program does not guarantee full payment of a player's registration fees. The RSC has established a limited fund to assist players. Fee assistance award amounts will be based on the number of applicants and available funds.
5. If financial aid is awarded, the player may be eligible for a free uniform.
  - If the player is new to the club, the club will purchase 1 white jersey, 1 navy jersey, 1 shorts and 1 pair of socks.
  - If the player's entire team is buying new uniforms per the club's policy, the club will purchase 1 white jersey, 1 navy jersey, 1 shorts and 1 pair of socks.
6. All financial aid requests will be held in the strictest of confidence by the RSC Financial Aid Committee and the RSC Board of Directors. All requests shall be answered within one (1) board meeting cycle.
7. Financial aid awards must meet with the approval of the Financial Aid Committee. All financial aid requests must be received by the November board meeting to be approved at that meeting. Any financial aid requests submitted after the November board meeting are subject to availability of funds and will be accepted on a case-by-case basis at the Board's discretion.
8. Financial aid recipients agree to the commitment of competitive traveling soccer, including but not limited to, practices and tournaments.
